Chastening of the Lord:

- not grievous
- BUT KIND

The Lord's desire:

- That we TRUST HIM
- Even as we say WE LOVE HIM

Many of us are like that sheep:

- Determined to go our own way
- Do what we think is right to do
- Without consulting the word of God
- Without listening to the Spirit of God

Because of:

- His love for us
- His desire for His WILL to be done in our lives
- He chastens us like a loving father
- That we may learn that His INTENTIONS TOWARD US ARE GOOD

## EMOTIONALLY

- Your glory (honor) before the Lord is gone - 1 Peter 1:8 [KJV](#)
- That means the guilt about my past is not gone - Ecclesiastes 5:20 [KJV](#)
- That means I start depending now on my circumstances to make me happy, rather than Christ to give me joy.

4) \_\_\_\_\_ **GONE** - Psalm 29:11 [KJV](#); Isaiah 48:18 [KJV](#)

When my peace is gone...

- a) Means my mind is not on Him - **Isaiah 26:3** [KJV](#)
- b) Means I'm confused about all things - **Philippians 4:7** NKJV
- c) Means the Lord's countenance is not upon you - **Numbers 6:26** NKJV
- d) Means I can't hear Him when He speaks - **Psalm 85:8** [KJV](#)
- e) Means the Lord is not working in me - **Isaiah 26:12** [KJV](#)
- f) Means I'm in wickedness - **Isaiah 48:22** [KJV](#)
- g) Means there is no guidance from the Lord - **Luke 1:79** [KJV](#)

## PERSONALLY
