**"Blessings Come As You Walk In Obedience!"**

**Introduction:**

The Lord has a plan for everyone He has called and chosen, but we have to follow His plan for our lives. Most of us waste many years following the ways of the world. We stick to that life even if it is hindering, or holding up blessings, even killing us because we think there is no better way. The Lord knows the plans He has for you, to prosper you not to harm you, plans for a hope and a future. (Jeremiah 29:11)

The Lord has many blessings He is waiting to give us for our lives when we decide to listen, and walk out **His plans** in **obedience** to him. In this passage, there are at least three things that help us walk in obedience causing us to receive God's blessings.
