PERSEVERANCE BECAUSE OF EX...

2 Timothy 3:1-9 NKJV

Hermeneutics – proper principles for studying the Bible.

Exegesis – reading OUT OF the text that which may not be obvious through casual reading, actual intended meaning.

Eisegesis – reading INTO the text what is not there, interpreter's own ideas, bias.

1) BUT KNOW THIS – ______ - 2 Timothy 3:1-4 NKJV

- Paul was Explicit about Perilous times difficult, hard to deal with, dangerous (Mt 8:28, demoniac), like a cornered animal, like Satan's last-ditch effort
- Paul was Explicit about the signs of the perilous times 18 perilous activities are signs of increasing perilous times Selfish & Self-centered, wrong kind of love
- Self-Check Psalm 139:23-24 NKJV
- I pray your Self-Check checked out. If not...

Confess your sins to the Lord - 1 John 1:9 NKJV

Confess your faults one to another - James 5:16 NKJV

"BUT KNOW THIS" – <u>EXPLICIT</u>

2) "HAVING BUT DENYING" – ______ - 2 Timothy 3:5 NKJV

Paul is talking about religious folk

- Religious in a negative sense
- Look good on the outside, depraved thinking and living

Heart of the matter is a matter of the HEART!

- They perverted God's local churches
- They resisted God's spokespersons
- They opposed God's truth

Exclusion in Perilous times:

- Difficult, hard to deal with, dangerous (Mt 8:28, demoniac)
- Like a cornered animal
- Like Satan's last-ditch effort against Christ

Turn Away:

- Once they lied about their religiosity
- Once they defied the local Body of Christ
- Once they denied the truth of the Gospel message
- Then FROM SUCH PEOPLE TURN AWAY!

We are to practice EXCLUSION from those who deny the truth of the Word of God.

3) "THIS SORT" – - 2 Timothy 3:6-9 NKJV

If 3:1-5 can be summarized as Lovers of Money and Pleasure Then 3:6-7 summarizes "THIS SORT" as Depraved Living and Thinking

Descriptive wordings: Creep into, Take captive, Gullible, Led away

They victimize the spiritually weak, like Pharoah's magicians, They resist the truth and they oppose the truth tellers

4) "BUT YOU" – ______ - 2 Timothy 3:10 NKJV

3:1-4 – Eighteen depraved characteristics

3:1-11 – Nine godly, exemplary, God-pleasing characteristics
