•	Carefully followed (Greek: parakoloutheo') - literally means to accompany. Used metaphorically of conforming to something as a matter of conviction.
•	William Barclay says; "Term" means to follow a person physically, to stick by him through thick and thin, to be by his side in fair weather and bad. It means to follow a person mentally to attend diligently to his teaching and fully understand the meaning and the significance of what he says. It means to follow a person spiritually, not only to understand what he says, but also to carry out his ideas, and to be the kind of person that he wishes us to be.
•	In Greek, the definite article "my" precedes each of the descriptive nouns in theses verse i.e.: My doctrine, My manner of life; My faith; My long-suffering lovepersecution afflictions
