TO DEFEND FAITH, REQUIRES OBEDIENCE TO NOTHING BUT THE WORD...

1) REQUIRES _____ - 2 Timothy 3:10-11a NKJV

- **Carefully followed** (Greek: *parakoloutheo*) - literally means to accompany. Used metaphorically of conforming to something as a matter of conviction.
 - William Barclay says;
“Term” means to follow a person physically, to stick by him through thick and thin, to be by his side in fair weather and bad. It means to follow a person mentally to attend diligently to his teaching and fully understand the meaning and the significance of what he says. It means to follow a person spiritually, not only to understand what he says, but also to carry out his ideas, and to be the kind of person that he wishes us to be.
 - In Greek, the definite article “my” precedes each of the descriptive nouns in these verse: i.e.: My doctrine, My manner of life; My faith; My long-suffering... love...persecution... afflictions...

2) BRINGS _____ - 2 Timothy 3:11b-12 NKJV

- **Persecution** – Greek: *diogmos* - means to harass; to chase or pursue.
- John 16:33 NKJV
- 2 Corinthians 12:10 NLT

3) REVEALS _____ - 2 Timothy 3:13 NKJV

- **Imposters** (Greek: *goe's*) – also means swindler, charlatan, hypocrite, or fraud/pretenders.
- Psalm 26:4 NLT

4) REQUIRES _____ - 2 Timothy 3:14-15 NKJV

- **Must continue** (Greek: *meno*) - means to remain, to keep, stay with...
- **Been assured of** - means “that which I have come to believe!”
- Ephesians 6:18 NKJV

5) IS _____ - 2 Timothy 3:16-17 NKJV

- **Profitable** (Greek: *ophelimos*) - means to be beneficial, productive and sufficient.
- **Scripture is beneficial, productive, and sufficient, it is Profitable.**
- David understood the profitability of the Word of God in one of his most uplifting psalms.
