Jesus begins by emphasizing that the Spirit of the Lord is upon Him. This statement goes to the issue of being influenced by Holy Spirit, which goes beyond human effort—it's about divine guidance and strength. As believers, it's not just about what we do, but how we let God's Spiritual values shape our actions, even in politics and social justice...involvement.

	•	This isn't just about material or physical poverty, but about addressing the lack of hope and opportunity, that people experience in marginalized communities.					
	•	In politics, it means considering policies that uplift marginalized communities and advocate for equitable opportunities for all.					
	Jesus also speaks of Liberation and Restoration.						
	•	When He talks about setting captives free and restoring sight to the blind.					
	•	It emphasizes the importance of working towards systems that free individuals from injustice and ignorance, fostering fairness and equality Proverbs 31:8-9 CSB Isaiah 1:16-18 NKJV James 1:27 NKJV
